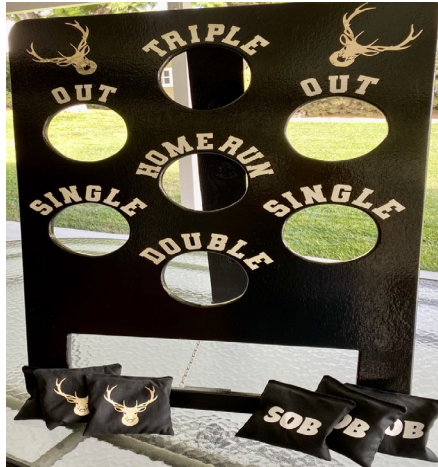
### Golden Palms RV Resort, Hemet
